This session will focus on setting up classes and assessments within the program, as well as analyzing the data that is available.

- Create a test or benchmark
- Add assignment/test/benchmark to class
- Create a question to add to an assignment

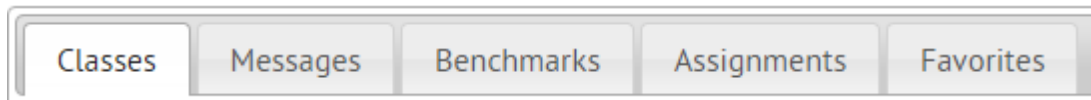
Task 4:

About The Tabs:



- *Classes*
 - Class options
 - **Resources:** Online and printable resources such as handouts and bellringers. Also includes whole group games.
 - **Class Results:** Shows individual grades for each student.
 - **Progress Report:** Dot rank-whole class (all standards), dot rank-student (all standards), monthly progress graphs
 - **Gradebook:** Shows overall dot rank for each student on each assignment.
 - **Manage Class:** Edit class, print password cards, view student statistics, etc.



- *Messages*
 - Can send messages/notifications to students about the work. Can turn off the option for students to reply.
- *Benchmarks*
 - Can create benchmark tests over multiple standards that can be shared by multiple teachers.
 - Question types: multiple choice, teacher-written, performance tasks, and free response
- *Assignments*
 - Can create practice assignments or tests for students to take.
 - Can use as many standards as needed.
 - Can access shared assignments
- *Favorites*
 - View questions manually added.
 - Create/save new questions
